



The Boys & Girls Clubs of Bellevue operates licensed childcare programs and accepts the **Department of Children, Youth, and Family Services (DCYF) - Working Connections Child Care (WCCC)** subsidy at select locations:

*Provide number not required to apply.*

- Ardmore Elementary
- Lake Hills Elementary
- Newport Heights Elementary
- Preschool Programs at ALL locations

If you are interested in enrolling one of these locations and looking for financial assistance for program fees, **families must apply for WCCC & BrightSpark first before applying for Boys & Girls Clubs of Bellevue financial assistance.** WCCC helps ensure long term access to care and allows us to support more families. When you apply for WCCC, you can also apply for other state benefits through the same application.

The WCCC application process can take up to **30 days**, so it is recommended to apply as early as possible.

**You may qualify if:**

- You **live in Washington State**
- Your **child is under 13** and a **U.S. citizen or legal resident**
- Your **household income is at or below 60%** of the State Median Income
- A parent or guardian is **working, self-employed, or enrolled in school or training**

**Additional support is available for families:**

- Experiencing **homelessness**
- Caring for **children with special needs**
