

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Bellevue operates licensed child care programs and accepts the **Working Connections Child Care (WCCC)** subsidy at select locations:

- Ardmore Elementary
  - o Provider ID # 695722
  - Note: Before School Program for Ardmore Elementary at Sherwood Forest Elementary NOT included
- Newport Heights Elementary
  - o Provider ID # 2536175

If you are interested in enrolling one of these locations and looking for financial assistance for program fees, families must apply for WCCC first before applying for Boys & Girls Clubs of Bellevue financial assistance. WCCC helps ensure long term access to care and allows us to support more families. When you apply for WCCC, you can also apply for other state benefits through the same application.

The WCCC application process can take up to **30 days**, so it is recommended to apply as early as possible.

## You may qualify if:

- You live in Washington State
- Your child is under 13 and a U.S. citizen or legal resident
- Your household income is at or below 60% of the State Median Income
- A parent or guardian is working, self-employed, or enrolled in school or training

## Additional support is available for families:

- Experiencing homelessness
- Caring for children with special needs
